Exclusive Tour Overview

Mpumalanga – The Lowveld

The Kruger Lowveld region of Mpumalanga is a 3.5 billion year old ancient landscape framed by what is likely the oldest mountain range on Earth, preserving some of life's earliest forms. One look down from the rugged Klein Drakensberg Escarpment allows one to understand why God's Window is so called. The mountain cliffs and those of the Blyde River Canyon plunge down, laden with waterfalls, into lush indigenous forest where the iconic Kruger National Park and private game reserves make the region one of Africa's signature wildlife destinations.

Apart from breathtaking natural icons, this is also a place of historical and cultural significance. Iron Age trade routes and African traditions reach back across many centuries. Gold rushes at Pilgrims Rest and Barberton were precursors to the discovery of gold in Johannesburg. Steeped in the history of traditional cultures, pioneers and fortune seekers such as Percy Fitzpatrick who wrote *Jock of the Bushveld*, visitors will encounter a contemporary Lowveld culture with a wealth of stories that inspire the senses and connect one to the land and its people

The Kruger Lowveld is also a place of easily reached frontiers where you can visit three countries in one day by road, or take a leisurely drive, because this is also a place for solitude, relaxation self-discovery, and connecting with nature.

The positioning statement embodies the concept of an ancient and beautiful landscape, a vibrant living culture and a rich history. The Lowveld has unequalled riches and it continues to tell its stories through today's contemporary culture.

Statements that position the Lowveld as a globally significant region are listed below:

- It is one of the great natural wonders of the world. (Blyde River Canyon, Bourkes Luck Potholes, etc)

Cape Town - SA's Mother City

The Mother City of South Africa occupies one of the world's most stunning locations, with an iconic mountain slap-bang in her centre. As beautiful as the surrounding beaches and vineyards can be, it's the rugged wilderness of Table Mountain, coated in a unique flora that grabs everyone's attention.

Long before the Dutch took a fancy to the Cape Peninsula in the 17th century, the land was home to the Khoisan people who valued the spiritual power of the mountains and their life-providing water. While the European immigrants, and the slaves they brought here, have all shaped the physical environment of South Africa's third-largest city, Table Mountain - now protected within a national park that covers some 75% of the peninsula - remains at Cape Town's heart. This ever present backdrop is the city's adventure playground, as well as a source of legend and continuing spiritual nourishment. Under the Khoisan name of Hoerikwaggo - meaning 'Mountain in the Sea' - the national park is promoting a new series of trails that will allow visitors, for the first time, to sleep on the mountain top while hiking a world-class trail from Cape Point to the City Bowl.

Complementing the mountain's natural beauty is Cape Town's eye-catching way with design and colour in everything from the brightly painted façades of the Bo-Kaap and the Victorian bathing chalets of Muizenberg, to the contemporary Afro-chic décor of the many excellent guesthouses, restaurants and bars. The city is crammed with galleries displaying amazing artworks and shops selling wonderfully inventive craftwork. It's also getting a reputation as the fashion nexus of South Africa. This creativity seems to spring naturally from the city's multiethnic population, proof of South Africa's status as the rainbow nation and a visual record of the country's tumultuous recorded history of over 350 years.

Cape Town is an old pro at showing visitors a good time. There are plenty of great wildlife-spotting opportunities, from the penguins at Boulders to the antelopes, buffaloes and black rhino at Solole Game Reserve. The restaurants and bars compare favourably with those of other cosmopolitan cities. There's a lively cultural scene, particularly when it comes to music, which pervades every corner of the city, and if outdoor activities and adrenaline buzzes are your thing, you've come to the right place. As local troubadour David Kramer's sing-along anthem for the Cricket World Cup has it, 'Welcome to Cape Town/Enjoy the party/Come in and have some fun/Cape Town's number one'.

The capital of Western Cape Province and the parliamentary capital of the republic, Cape Town works in a way that so few cities on the African continent do. Historic buildings have been saved, businesses are booming, inner-city crime is coming under control and you'll seldom be stuck for a parking space. Factor back in those stunning mountains, magnificent surf beaches and outstanding vineyards and you'll soon discover - like many before you - that it's easy to lose track of time while exploring all the wonders of this unique Southern African city.

Walking about 3 kilometres' over easy terrain is required to participate in some of the activities. Travellers are not required to participate in every activity.

Getting There & Getting Home

We will pre booked spaces for our guests on flights, on confirmation, from O R Tambo International Airport (Johannesburg, Gauteng) to KMIA (Nelspruit, Mpumalanga) to Cape Town International Airport (Western Cape).

You should plan your International Flights to arrive in Johannesburg before the last flight departing O R Tambo (Joburg) to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport (KMIA / Nelspruit) to avoid an overnight at a hotel at or near to the Airport.

Our current flight schedules, for the routing from Johannesburg to Nelspruit, have the last flight departing at 17H30 on a daily basis except for a Saturday and a Sunday.

If this is not possible, we recommend you book a night in Johannesburg and you should plan on arriving in Johannesburg a day prior to your tour.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Depart from OR Tambo International Airport (Johannesburg) to KMIA (Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport) – Nelspruit. (Your Internal Domestic flight is dependant on your International Flight Arrival).

Upon arrival at KMIA Airport (Nelspruit), you will be met by one of our representatives and transferred to JGI Chimpanzee Eden.

Day 2: Your day is spent at your leisure and partaking in the Special & Exclusive Chimpanzee Tours.

Guided tour through our Education Hall, curios centre and enclosure walkways.

Tour duration: 1 hour and 30 minute feeding tour specials at 10h00 & 14h00 each day as well as a 12H00 non-feeding tour. Meals and refreshments are available from the onsite restaurant called Junglicious.

Other activities are available from Chimp Eden Boutique Hotel.

Day 3: Rise early for your transfer via the magnificent Panoramic Route , to a Private Safari Lodge, situated in the Sabi Sands Game Reserve which forms part of the Greater KRUGER NATIONAL PARK.

Mpumalanga Province's Drakensberg Mountains divide the cooler Highveld to the west from the lower coastal plains to the east. This natural phenomenon creates a display of splendid panoramic scenery. This tour visits the Victorian Town of Pilgrim's Rest, Robber's Grave, Blyde River Canyon, The Three Rondavels, God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes and Lisbon Waterfalls. This scenic area is also steeped in early Southern African history. Lunch is included.

Day 4 to Day 6: Your Private Safari Lodge offers early morning and Sundowner game drives in open game-viewing Land Rovers. Bush walks with trained guides. Health Spa's and Gym facilities are available at most of the lodges. Optional additional activities can be arranged if advised well in advance e.g. River rafting, quad bike tours, cultural tours, hot-air ballooning, and elephant-back safaris etc.

Day 6: You will be collected from Your Private Safari Lodge and transferred to KMIA Airport (Nelspruit) for your flight from Nelspruit to Cape Town International Airport.

Upon your arrival at Cape Town International Airport, you will be met by one of our representatives and transferred to your Hotel at the famous V & A Waterfront.

Day 6 – 9: Your 3 night stay, in what is considered as one the most beautiful city in the world, is spent at your leisure. You can spend your time exploring the V & A Waterfront and what is on offer e.g. Two Oceans Aquarium, Curio shops, general shopping stores, or dining at some of the best restaurants in the country. Full Day and Half Day tours can be arranged to further explore the Cape Peninsular e.g. Robben Island, Wine Lands, Table Mountain etc (see below a few examples of tours available)

The Chimpanzee groups live within large semi-wild enclosures that are close to their natural habitat. The enclosures also have viewpoints overlooking the forest and 'foraging areas'. The 'foraging areas' have small fruits and berries mixed in Eucalyptus Tree leaves. These 'foraging areas' will provide the Chimpanzees with behavioural enrichment and will also provide visitors that arrive after the feeding time with a better chance to view them in the large enclosures.

Chimps like other Great Apes (Gorillas and Orang Utans) are finding an ever growing interest from the public, as they are the closest relatives to Human Kind and they are facing a quick extinction in their natural habitat.
